#### **REACHING NET ZERO**

Richard Fuller, MP for our area, has been visiting local schools to hear pupil's views on climate change, prior to attending COP26 in Glasgow. As a member of the Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) Select Committee, he recently questioned expert witnesses attending that Committee, for their views on the Government's recently unveiled Heat and Buildings Strategy. He stated that there is a need for transparency, as some of the changes may require higher taxes or taxpayer funding, particularly for technologies yet to prove themselves. He went on to say that intelligent choices will need to be made to limit costs to the taxpayers and ideally create export opportunities for British businesses as we move towards Net Zero. #### **COMMITMENT TO CARERS**

Central Bedfordshire are undertaking surveys in early December with Carers who have had

family or friends or the person they care for admitted to hospital for elective or emergency admissions in the last six months. The aim is to understand, from a carers perspective, what processes/outcomes are most important to get right before leaving hospital. The interview can take place in your own home at a time most convenient to you, or in a setting of your choosing. All participants will be offered a £15 gift voucher for taking part as long as the person they care for meets the criteria of someone who was recently discharged from hospital. Once all the interviews are completed we will arrange a focus group with representatives from the local authority, social care, acute hospital, Carers lead/discharge team leader, and a health commissioner involved in the discharge process to feedback the results, and to ask what actions they will take as a result of the feedback provided.

Boosters and third jabs will normally be Pfizer or Moderna. You will need to ask, but Astra Zeneca is available for those prone to allergies. Nearest walk in Centres are the old Argos Store, Garden Square Shopping Centre in Letchworth, Council Offices, Chicksands (Priory House) and Robertson House in Stevenage.

**Green Homes Grant for cavity and loft insulation** Homeowners living in Central Bedfordshire can now apply for grant funding to pay for loft and cavity wall insulation from the government's Green Homes Grant Scheme. Terms and conditions apply and only private homeowners with a combined annual income of up to £30,000 will be eligible. You must also have an Energy Performance Certificate for your home of E F or G; for loft insulation your loft needs to be totally clear.
