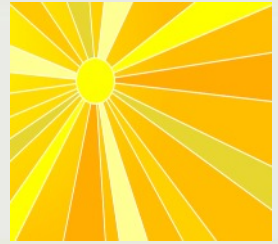

children and doing a few jobs as well.

Hands at Work, the charity that will be 'hosting' the team work in 8 sub-Saharan African countries to encourage local communities to care for and look after the many many orphaned and vulnerable children caused by the Aids crisis.

The team will aim to support and encourage the care workers as they seek to care for the children in their community. But they will also find the experience life-changing as they interact and come to know these inspiring people.
